Hamersley Committee Guidelines (Standing Orders)

(Updated February 2021)

CLUB COMMITTEE

The "Hamersley Hash House Harriers(inc.) Rules - revised 2018", (H4 Rules) sets out the general roles and responsibilities of the committee. The H4 Committee Job Descriptions sets out roles and responsibilities of each committee member in detail.

The Head of the club is the **Grand Master (GM)** and he is to be respected and listened to at all times. The committee will support the **GM** on all things that will ensure the safe and longevity of the club. The outgoing committee will endeavour to keep all documentation in an orderly and in an up-to-date state to ensure a smooth hand over to the new elected committee.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING (AGM)

The **AGM** is to be held annually, on the closest Monday to 13th November. The outgoing committee will be acknowledged and stood down, and the new committee will be voted in. Voting will be in accordance with the **H4 Rules.**

This event is a Members only event and non-members allowed only at the invitation of the committee.

Hamersley Perpetual Foot and GM's Jacket

The Hamersley Perpetual Foot and GM's jacket are to be updated with the incoming GMs details by the current GM and passed on to the incoming GM on the first Monday Night after the AGM. The Ex-GM will recite the Ode.

It has, for many years, been entrusted to the hands and feet of the worthy and distinguished Hashmen, who have been democratically elected to represent all that is good and honourable in our mighty club, Hamersley. Committee Meeting

The First Committee meeting of the New Committee is to be held at 7.30 pm on the last Tuesday before the end of November or as soon as possible afterwards. Location to be notified 1 week prior to the meeting.

Meetings thereafter be held on a Tuesday evening, with a 7.00 p.m. muster for 7.30p.m. start of meeting. Drinks and snacks at the discretion of the Committee. Chairman of the meeting to aim for a 9.30 p.m. close of meeting. Meetings to be held as necessary but with an aim to

have one at least every quarter. Location will be at Committee Members houses (on a voluntary basis)

A quorum for the committee meeting will be as set out in the H4 Rules, being at least 5 committee members, two of which are Office Bearers.

All major club decisions are made by committee on the basis of 1 vote per committee member with the GM having the casting vote.

New Members

- New Members to complete an application form and submit to the On-Sec for tabling to all members of the committee.
- Once approved, the new member to Pay Subs and receive a Car Sticker, an Annual and a Hamersley Run Shirt.
- Only receive a Hash Name when they do something to deserve one.
- When any New Member joins the Club, his details to be added to the Members List and be made available for all committee members.
- Run numbers commence from membership date. (visits not counted)

GENERAL

Ice: To be used sparingly and wisely. Non-Hash visitors to be spared (unless he deserves it)

Dogs: No dogs at Hash

Fighting: Fighting or continued targeted verbal abuse of a member at Hash results in instant dismissal for the instigator. Committee to adjudicate and GM to execute the order.

Beer Tokens: Beer tokens can be purchased from the Hash Cash (or Hash Splash in his absence) in exchange for acholic and non-alcoholic beverages.

Token cost and allocation to be reviewed at least annually by the committee but currently set as follows:

Small cans / bottles of beer (VB,MID,Hahn etc)	1 token
Mid-priced beer (Toohey's old)	1.5 tokens
Large beers (Guinness, Kilkenny) and spirit-based drink	ks 2 tokens

Special Events

- AGM Free night for paid up full members.
 - Non-Members and Visitors pay \$30 if invited by committee
 - 100 litres of Beer (266 cans) & soft drinks are Rations.
 - All special drinks eg; Scotch, Bourbon, Kilkenny etc, you pay Bar Price.
 - Food.
 - Entertainment (optional)
- Hashmas Sundowner -Up to \$200 Platters supplied by Club. (reimburse by raffle)

- Xmas Run
 - Visitors pay \$30
 - Food
 - Rations 100lts of Beer, or 266 Cans.
 - Mary Xmas x 1

• Rest-o-Rant Run

-Members pay \$10.00 towards their meal

-Club picks up remaining Bill aim is to but limit to Total of \$20.00 per head -drinks charged at normal club rates

-Visitors to pay \$30.00 per head which includes 4 tokens

• Black Fridays and Sundowners

-Are to be discussed and planned by the Committee.

-A Sub-Committee may be formed and they will report to the Committee.

-All major events to be planned at least 2 months prior, so as to have time to promote said event.

• Hamersley to send 2 representatives to each Club to promote Special Events.

- To organize runs past their term of office up to Christmas.
- To always have a backup Run planned in case of Emergency.
- Joint Masters enter the following Runs in their Run Calendar on hand over to the new committee at the start of our Hash year.

Mary Xmas Run (H4): Last Monday before Xmas day

Not the Kings Park Run (Joint): Between Xmas and New Year

Boot's Memorial Run & Fallen Hamersley Hashmen (H4): (2nd Monday in January.) (list of fallen Hamersley Hashman in attached Appendix A)

Australia Day Run (H4): (Closest Monday to 26th January)

Blue Dress Run (Joint): Tuesday, March Long Weekend) In the name of Motor Neuron A tribute to "Waddles" a loved and respected Harriette. St Patrick's Day Run (H4): Closest Monday to 17th March

ANZAC Day Run (H4): Closest Monday to 25th April

Mother's Day Run (H4): (flowers/chocolates for Mother first Monday after Mother's Day)

Palace Run (Joint): Long Weekend in June (Usually second Tuesday in June)

Rest - o - Rant Run (H4): Third Monday in June

City to Park Run (Joint): subject to demand (late August. Committee to organize. Get Flyers out to other clubs at least 6 weeks prior)
